TALENT COMPETITION IMMORTAL SHOWDOWN REGISTRATION & FEES

STUDIO REGISTRATION – \$175.00 per Studio (Due by May 1, 2026)

Studio registration includes:

1. Your studio's placement will be secured once all dancer fees are paid in full.
2. Eligibility to compete in designated categories and divisions.
3. Complimentary entry badges for:
 - One (1) Director
 - Two (2) Coaches
 - One (1) Makeup Artist/Stylist

DANCER FEES – \$50 per dancer (Due by June 15, 2026)

Dancer fee includes:

DAY 1: DANCE MASTER CLASSES (*Optional but Highly Recommended*)

- Train with five (5) industry judges/instructors

- Five (5) hours of immersive training
- Develop technique, confidence, and knowledge to support growth as an artist

Participation in master classes is not required to compete. Dancers who do not attend will still pay the \$50 competition fee.

DAY 2: COMPETITION DAY

- Full access to compete in your registered categories and divisions

COMPETITION SCHEDULE

Director's Meeting (Zoom): 5:00 PM (EST) on July 9, 2026

Director Check-In: 9:30 AM on Friday, July 31, 2026

Dancer and staff wristbands, along with any advanced tickets for competition day, will be distributed at Director Check-In.

TALENT COMPETITION CATEGORIES

All custom mixes (Duo, Fab 5, and Stand Battle) will be sent once dancer fees are paid in full .

FIELDSHOW / PRODUCTION CATEGORY

Division 1: Mini/Junior (12 years old and under)

Division 2: All Age Division

This is a high-impact, entertainment-driven category focused on storytelling, creativity, and overall performance quality. Routines must not exceed 5:00 minutes.

Judges will evaluate appearance, formations, execution, skill level, technique, personality, spacing, stunts, timing, difficulty, originality, and choreography. Teams are expected to maximize the floor with strong visuals, dynamic levels, and innovative transitions.

Props may be used and should enhance the overall production while remaining safe and performance appropriate. You will have 2:00 minutes for prop set up and break down.

Think outside the box—this is your moment to create a full production. Engage the audience and deliver a SHOW.

POM CATEGORY

Division 1: Mini/Junior (12 years old and Under)

Division 2: All Age

This is a high-energy, precision-based category emphasizing strong pom technique and visual performance. Routines must not exceed 3:00 minutes, with at least 90% performed using poms. Stunts are permitted without poms.

Judges will evaluate pom use, synchronization, technique, precision, formations, spacing (intervals), transitions, musicality, showmanship, energy, creativity, and originality. Routines should demonstrate clean, sharp motions, strong visual design, effective groundwork, and seamless transitions throughout.

Poms must be actively incorporated and essential to the routine's overall impact.

HIP HOP CATEGORY

Division 2: All age ** Hip Hop Grand Champion title, independent of other divisions**

This is a high-energy, performance-driven category emphasizing authenticity, control, and musicality. Routines must not exceed 3:00 minutes.

Judges will evaluate execution of movement and skills, synchronization/uniformity, spacing, communication/projection, creativity, musicality, staging, complexity, difficulty, choreography, and originality. Dancers should appear confident, comfortable, and fully in their element throughout the performance.

Commercial or social media choreography (including TikTok dances) is NOT permitted.

IMMORTAL FACE OFF – DUO BATTLE

Division 1: Mini/Junior (12 years old and under)

This is a high-intensity battle category where all teams take the floor together.

- Round 1: Fast Tempo (Tag Team Style)
Each dancer will perform 30 seconds each (1:00 minute total)
50% of participants will be eliminated at the end of Round 1
- Round 2: Custom Mix (Medium & Fast Tempo)
Both dancers must perform together for the full 1:00 minute

Final placements (1st, 2nd, and 3rd place) will be determined by the judges and announced at the close of the show. This is a head-to-head showdown—bring chemistry, confidence, and control. Stand out and own the floor.

IMMORTAL FACE OFF – FAB FIVE (5) BATTLE

Division 2: All Age

This is a high-intensity battle category where all teams take the floor together.

- Round 1: Fast Tempo (Tag Team Style)
Each dancer will perform 15 seconds each (1:15 minutes total)
50% of participants will be eliminated at the end of Round 1
- Round 2: Custom Mix (Medium & Fast Tempo)
All five (5) dancers must perform together for the full 1:00 minute

Final placements (1st, 2nd, and 3rd place) will be determined by the judges and announced at the close of the show. This is a head-to-head showdown—bring chemistry, confidence, and control. Stand out and own the floor.

STAND BATTLE

Mini/Junior Division (12 years old and under)

All Age Division

This is a head-to-head, knockout-style battle—bring your best and compete with control and respect.

Time Limit: Length of the custom mix

Counts begin once the team initiates movement

Continuing after the music stops or audibly counting off 8s once the music ends will result in automatic disqualification. NO unsportsmanlike behavior will be tolerated. NO crossing the line (results in disqualification)—including hair, props, or physical contact with opponents. All performances must remain controlled, respectful, and competition appropriate. Judges will reward precision, control, confidence, and overall impact. This is a battle—be sharp, be strategic, and make it count.

STAND BATTLE FORMAT

1. Qualifying Stand: All teams perform (1) FAST stand, judges will choose the TOP 9 TEAMS...BRING YOUR BEST!!!
2. Preliminary: Coaches will pull numbers for Stand Battle Round 1 (1 Medium). One team per block will be eliminated in this round. To ensure the competition's integrity, numbers will be arranged as follows:

Block 1: #1, #4, #7

Block 2: #2, #5, #8

Block 3: #3, #6, #9

3. Semi-Finals: 6 teams (2 Blocks, 3 Teams per block) perform (Slow- All ages, Fast- Mini/Juniors)

Block 1: X, X, X

Block 2: X, X, X

4. Finals: 3 teams perform a custom mix (including all 3 tempos)

Block 1: X, X, X

SCORING CRITERIA (POM, FIELD SHOW, & HIP-HOP)

All decisions made by judges and event officials are FINAL and NOT subject to appeal.

Execution of Technique – 35 Points

- Technique in Transition, Placement, and Movement – 20 points
- Technical Skills – 15 points

Execution of Performance – 30 Points

- Projection and Performance – 20 points
- Uniformity of Movement & Stage Use/Transitions – 10 points

Artistry & Innovation – 35 Points

- Dynamics and Texture – 15 points
 - Style and Artistic Expression – 10 points
 - Choreography and Concept – 10 points

JUDGING, PENTALTIES, & DEDUCTIONS

TALENT COMPETITION

Late Arrival

- Arrivals after 9:30 AM will incur a 15-point deduction
- An additional 15-point deduction will be applied every 30 minutes late

2. Music Requirements

- All music must be clean/appropriate
- Failure to comply will result in a 10-point deduction
- Music must be submitted in advance to the DJ; a flash drive is permitted for backup only

3. Judge Interaction Policy

- No sponsors, coaches, parents, or affiliates may approach judges during the competition

- Violation will result in a 25-point deduction

4. Time Limit Violations

- Routines that exceed the allotted time will receive a 15-point deduction

IMMORTAL SHOWDOWN – EVENT RULES

THIS IS A COMPETITIVE, HIGH-STANDARDS EVENT. ALL PARTICIPANTS ARE EXPECTED TO OPERATE WITH DISCIPLINE, PROFESSIONALISM, AND RESPECT.

- Entries are accepted on a first-come, first-served basis. Once divisions reach capacity, registration will close with no exceptions.
- All fees must be paid by the outlined dates.
- No registrations will be accepted within 14 days of the event—NO EXCEPTIONS.
- Accepted payment methods: Zelle and/or Cash App (NON-REFUNDABLE)

TEAM CONDUCT REQUIREMENTS

- All teams must be always supervised by a registered coach or director.
- All performers, coaches, directors, parents, and affiliates are expected to display elite sportsmanship and professionalism.
- ANY unsportsmanlike conduct, including but not limited to:

- Disrespect toward judges, staff, or other teams
- Disruptive, aggressive, or inappropriate behavior
- Coaches and directors are fully responsible for the behavior of their team and affiliates both on and off the competition floor.

** Failure to follow event directives WILL result in immediate penalties, disqualification, and/or removal from the event WITHOUT REFUND.

COMPETITION REQUIREMENTS

- Only non-marking shoes are permitted on performance floors.
- A minimum of four (4) dancers is required to compete as a team.
- Only individuals listed on the official roster and registration form will be granted team access.

- Rosters must be submitted by July 15, 2026—NO EXCEPTIONS.
- Substitutions are permitted only in the case of injury and must be approved by event staff.
- NO outside food or beverages are allowed within the venue.

PROPS POLICY (STRICTLY ENFORCED)

Props are permitted; however: Props must be controlled, non-hazardous, and appropriate for all audiences. Any prop deemed unsafe, inappropriate, or disruptive by event officials will result in immediate removal of the prop, and/or point deductions or disqualification.

ZERO TOLERANCE POLICY

UNSPORTSMANLIKE BEHAVIOR WILL NOT BE TOLERATED UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES.
Event officials reserve the absolute right to remove any individual or team at their discretion.

WAIVER & LEGAL ACKNOWLEDGEMENT

RELEASE OF LIABILITY (LEGALLY BINDING)

By participating in IMMORTAL SHOWDOWN, the undersigned, on behalf of themselves, their dancers, team, organization, heirs, assigns, and representatives, knowingly and voluntarily releases, waives, discharges, and covenants not to sue IMMORTAL SHOWDOWN, its owners, directors, staff, affiliates, venue partners, and representatives from any and all liability, including but not limited to:

- Personal injury
- Property damage
- Financial loss
- Illness or death

This applies whether caused by negligence or otherwise, to the fullest extent permitted by law, arising out of or related to participation in the event or presence at event facilities, including travel to and from the event.

ASSUMPTION OF RISK

Participation in dance and athletic performance involves inherent risks, including but not limited to physical injury. The undersigned acknowledges and voluntarily assumes ALL risks, both known and unknown, even if arising from negligence.

MEDICAL AUTHORIZATION

In the event of injury or emergency where a parent/guardian cannot be reached, IMMORTAL SHOWDOWN is authorized to secure medical treatment deemed necessary. The undersigned affirms that all participants are physically and mentally fit to compete or have disclosed all relevant conditions.

MEDIA & LIKENESS RELEASE

The undersigned grants IMMORTAL SHOWDOWN and DBG Dance Association the irrevocable, perpetual right to use names, images, video, and likenesses for promotional, marketing, and commercial purposes across all platforms, without compensation.

PAYMENT & NO REFUND POLICY

ALL PAYMENTS ARE FINAL

Submission of registration and payment secures participation in the event. NO REFUNDS, TRANSFERS, OR CREDITS will be issued under any circumstances, including withdrawal, disqualification, or removal.

FINAL ACKNOWLEDGEMENT

By submitting registration and/or payment, the undersigned confirms that they have read, understood, and agreed to all rules and policies, accept full responsibility for their team and affiliates, and agree to abide by all decisions made by event officials.

THIS DOCUMENT IS MANDATORY. Failure to submit a complete and accurate roster by the deadline will result in **ineligibility to compete**, and/or **immediate disqualification from the event**

All roster information must match the official registration. Any discrepancies may result in penalties or disqualification at the discretion of event officials.
